

AYEAR OF ONLINE CHURCH


- March 2020 the shock of lockdown and church closures

- YouTube, Facebook, Zoom
- Distributed Paper Resources too
- "use of Zoom, WhatsApp, Facebook, Youtube, etc for a range of activities, including prayer meetings, bible studies, youth groups, c_h_i_l_d_r_e_n_'s__and youth groups, book clubs, coffee mornings, afternoon teas, novenas, quizzes, question and answer sessions, marriage courses, retreats, spiritual direction, membership classes, and more. Most faith leaders have directed members of their faith community to other opportunities for online services, fellowship or resources, with 81 percent indicating that they have done so."

SURVEY MAY 2020, 439 FAITH LEADERS - NORTHERN PROTESTANTS OVER-REPRESENTED





CONGREGATIONS HIGH AT EASTER

- Congregations are normally higher at Easter
- We know online engagement remains high
- But congregations tired and tech/ministry teams even more tired!
- Public opinion on our side 34% of non-Christians appreciate role of local church
- How do we maximise this do a £5 Facebook ad for your local area
- Potential new reach, getting the news out there to your village/town/city
- How else will they hear what you are doing online?

- How do we re-invent Easter rites for a digital age and transfer the core themes and values from physical church to online church?


